Friday, November 4, 2016 "Austrian Treasures"

Our first soloist of the season will be the newly appointed Philadelphia Orchestra Associate Concertmaster, Ying Fu, performing Mozart's Violin Concerto No. 5 in A Major, the "Turkish" concerto. The concert will open with Beethoven's powerful Overture to *Egmont*, and close with one of the most popular symphonies of all, the Symphony No. 1 in C Minor, by Johannes Brahms.

Friday, February 24, 2017 "The French Connection"

Warming us for Winter is a concert of French favorites. We will open with a suite for orchestra of the great melodies from Georges Bizet's ever-popular opera, *Carmen*. Singers from the Curtis Opera Theater will join us for arias and duets from other French operas. The concert will close with the great romantic Symphony in D Minor by César Franck.

Friday, May 5, 2017 "Beautiful Americana"

This stirring concert will feature American composers, old and new. Our piano soloist will be Curtis Institute faculty member Michelle Cann, performing *Rhapsody in Blue* by George Gershwin. The concert will open with the World Premiere performance of a piece composed for the Main Line Symphony Orchestra by Maurice Rissman. Other concert highlights include *American Salute* by Morton Gould, a suite from the film, *Our Town*, by Aaron Copland, and music by "The March King", John Philip Sousa.
